Saturday, November 5, 2016

<u>City of Kelowna</u> (short day, 75 km driving, relaxed, better option if weather poor)

- 0900 Start, then 45 min drive across city and up switch-back gravel road
- 0945 *Myra-Bellevue Provincial Park* (Myra access, high-elevation trestle bridge restoration in burnover of Douglas-Fir and Western Larch *10 degrees cooler than lower elevations, so be prepared for snow and ice, it'll wake us up in the morning!)
- 1130 Gallagher Canyon (fuel management on-going by Kelowna Fire Dept. to remove ladder fuels and slow future fire spread, inadvertently restoring open pine ecosystem, also invasive alien grasses and proliferation of recreational trails along transmission line corridor)
- 1200 Lunch (somewhere in Mission neighbourhood near Casorso and Lakeshore, several Pubs and Restaurants at this location)
- 1330 Mission Creek Restoration Initiative (recent removal of channelized berms and restoration of floodplain meanders for fish & wildlife)
- 1430 *Tantalus Vineyard* (partners in ecological stewardship, pesticide-free, organic wines, wine tasting)
- 1530 City of Kelowna Composting Facility (@ Landfill & Sewage, marketable products of Ogo-Grow and Glen-Grow, methane recovery and power generation)
- 1630 Knox Mountain Park & Apex Trail Restoration (lookouts over the lake and city, proliferation of recreational trails, strategies for curbing unsanctioned trail use, natural recovery)
- 1730 Downtown for supper (suggest "The Beer Institute" for flight of local beers and pizza)
