

The Midwest-Great Lakes SER Chapter is seeking sponsors for our tenth Annual Chapter Meeting that will be held April 20 to April 22, 2018 in Stevens Point, Wisconsin. The Midwest-Great Lakes SER Chapter is a regional SER chapter that serves the seven state region of Ohio, Indiana, Michigan, Illinois, Wisconsin, Minnesota, and Iowa. Our Annual Meetings have become known as excellent and exciting venues for ecological restoration. Our past nine Annual Meetings have attracted between 98 to 233 attendees from 21 states (all seven chapter states and California, Georgia, Kansas, Missouri, New York, Kentucky, Maryland, Mississippi, Nevada, Pennsylvania, South Dakota, Utah, Virginia, West Virginia), Ontario (Canada), and Bogota (Colombia) for this three day event. The typical structure of our meeting included poster session/sponsorship reception, keynote address, one to two plenary sessions, three to four concurrent oral presentation sessions, workshops, symposia, a business meeting, and offsite field trips. Our meeting theme is *Heeding the Call*, which represents our primary goal for the meeting of exploring how to promote the call to expand restoration efforts and partnerships beyond the typical site scale to larger spatial scales encompassing multiple ecosystem types. Our secondary goal is to bring together all who are interested in ecological restoration and contribute to advancing the field of ecological restoration. Our meeting agenda will be similar to our past six meetings and will include technical presentations, social events, workshops, and field trips
