Public Health Safety Protocols:

SER Midwest-Great Lakes Chapter is incorporating public health safety protocols into its meeting policies as part of our good faith efforts to hold a safe annual meeting for all participants. **Specifically, we expect all meeting participants (i.e., attendees, presenters, sponsors, exhibitors, etc.) at events associated with the in-person component of our meeting from April 14 to April 16, 2023 to agree they will not attend the in-person events on April 14 to April 16, 2023 if they contract the flu, test positive for COVID-19, test positive for RSV, and/or if they exhibit symptoms of the flu, COVID-19, or RSV. Additionally, we expect that all meeting attendees will respect the choices of other meeting attendees to wear a mask, request social distancing, and any other safety practices they wish to follow.**

Additionally, those attendees who wish to have a greater level of protection against circulating respiratory viruses are encouraged to:

-wear a mask

-practice good hygiene and wash hands or use sanitizer, avoid touching their face, and sneeze or cough into a tissue or the inside of the elbow.
