1. Board/Committee Reports

- a. Outreach Committee report (Mike)
 - i. 28 people at pub talk last night. Many people picked up fliers.
 - ii. Upcoming outreach committee meeting: main points of discussion will be future pub talks. 3 new members on outreach committee.
 - 1. Get something in southwestern CO.
 - iii. Put out a poll, as of last night 7 responded with vote for Pollinator workshop. Explore having it at Denver Botanic Gardens. Previously held at Butterfly Pavilion.
 - iv. Mike seeking a co-chair for outreach committee. Perhaps a person who could also step into chair position in future pending an election.
 - v. MP: Explore partnering for pub talk in NM or Utah. Great Basin Chapter is centered in Reno (UN). Marenna may be able to help connect with Reno chapter.
