• Log on to <u>ser.org</u> with you username/password and click on "Groups" on the right side panel under My Profile. Then select your Chapter / Section name from the list. (You'll see a person icon, which means you are a group admin. If you do not see this person icon send an email to <u>laura@ser.org</u> and 'cc your Chapter Chair to request access.)

- On your SER Chapter/Section Group page, you'll see a link "Group Admin Options" next to the same *person* icon. Click on that and you can export the chapter roster by clicking on Available Reports under the "Group Admin Options" link.
- To email members directly from the SER platform, click "Email all group members" under Member Communication. The system will only allow a plain text email. If you'd like rich text/html, then select "Message Group". Members will receive an email that a message is waiting for them.
